Diploma Workshop Schedule

The workshops have been divided into 2 terms.

Term 1 - 10 workshops (first workshop is 2 days)

Term 2 - 9 workshops

Research Report Requirements

- The Research Report should be no less than 5000 and no more than 7000 words in length, excluding appendices, table of contents and bibliography.
- The Report must incorporate no less than 8 secondary sources.
- The student must conduct the research and complete the Report under guidance of a Mentor.

How long do I have to complete the Diploma?

The 19 workshops prescribed in this program will take place over a period of 12 months

Your research report submission will be due 90 days after the last workshop of term 2.





What are the requirements for graduation?

In order to graduate, participants must attend no less than 16 out of the 19 workshops prescribed by this program.

After having fulfilled the attendance requirement, students must write a research report.

Attendance at the workshops and a 70% or higher grade on the report are required for graduation.





What happens if I miss a workshop?

You can miss up to 3 workshops without penalty.

You can attend missed sessions at any other location where the Diploma is being offered.

What is included in the Term fees and what other costs can I expect?

The fees cover the cost of all workshop materials.

You may on occasion be asked by a workshop facilitator to read a non-curricular book. For your research report, you will be required to refer to at least 8 secondary sources. These are not included in your fees.
