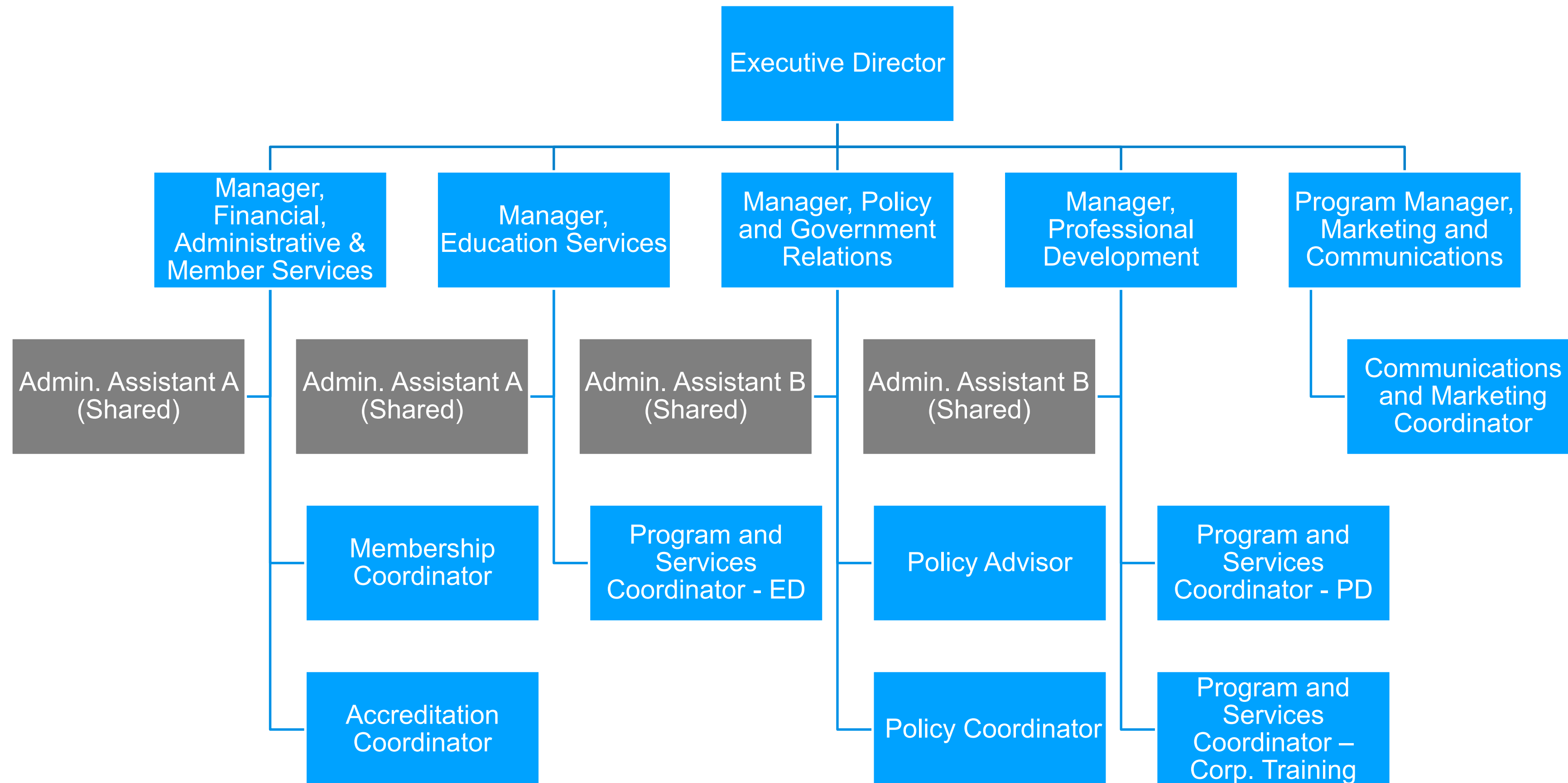

New AMCTO Organizational Structure

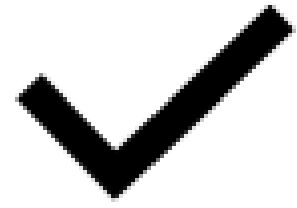

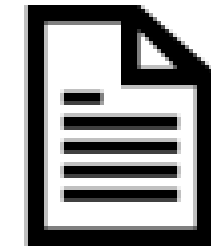


Voter's List
