

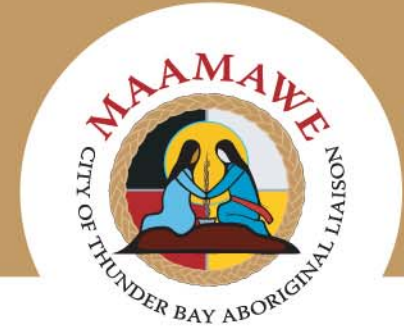

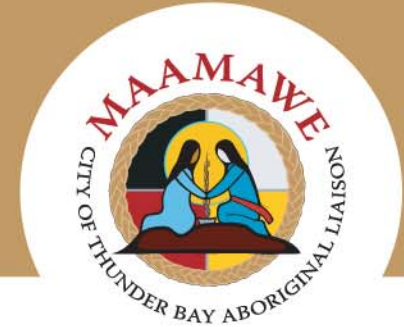

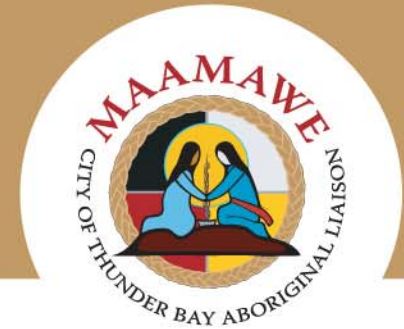
Goals for this session

- Build understanding among the people of Thunder Bay to create a safe, inclusive community for all people.

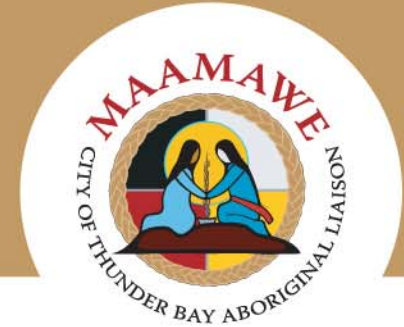
In Our Learning Environment



We all have a right to...

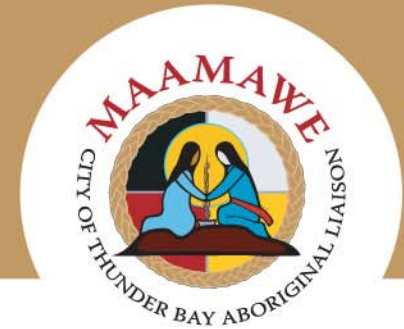
- learn

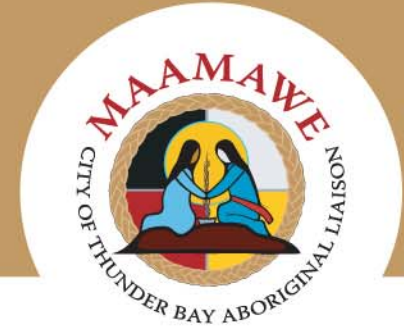

Film Two: We are all Treaty People



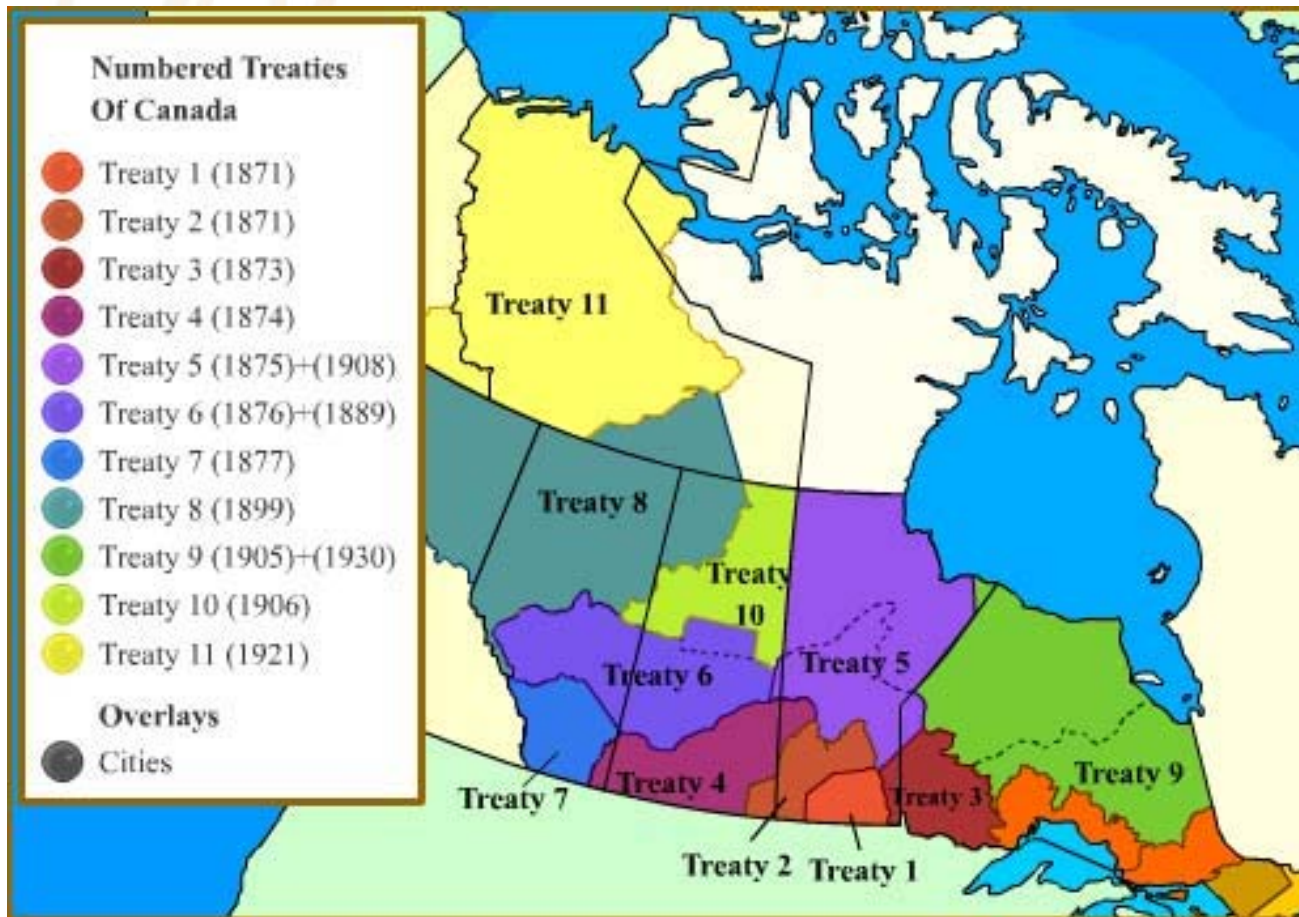

- How are contracts like Treaties?

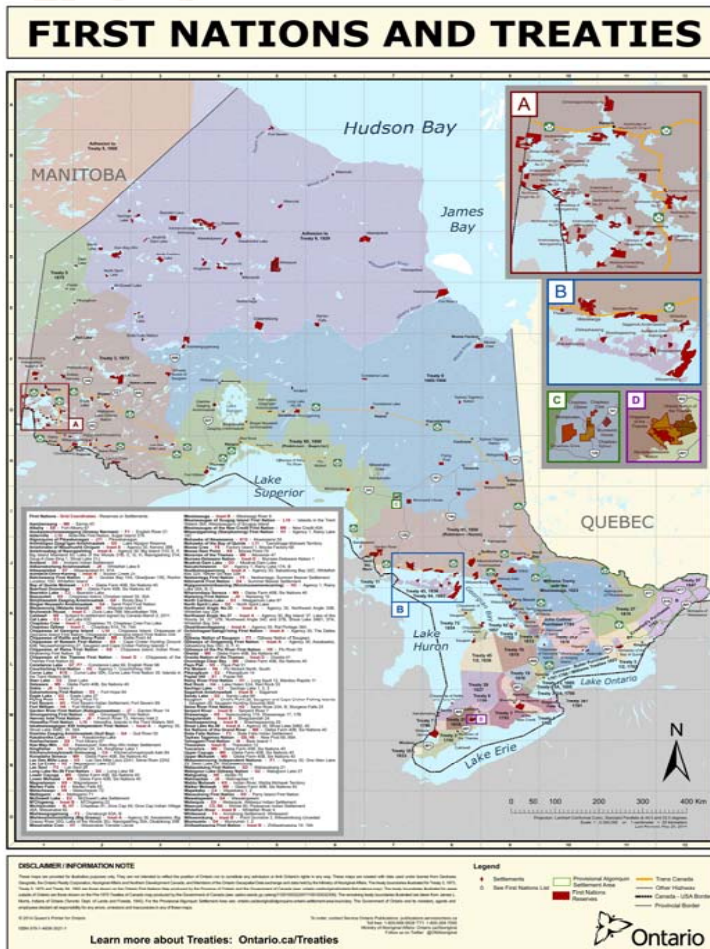
Treaties



Western Treaties



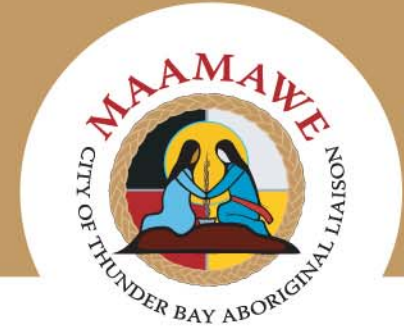
First Nations in Ontario



- There are 134 First Nations located throughout Ontario.

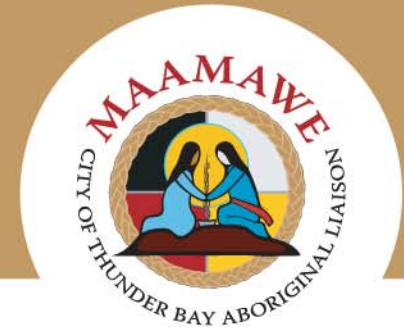


Film Two – Post-film Discussion

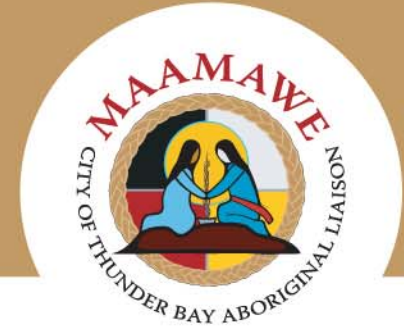


Colonial Policies of the last 100 Years

- What would your family, community be like if the children were gone?

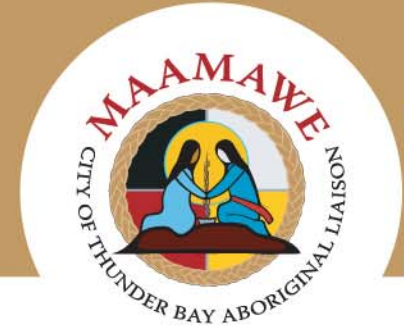
