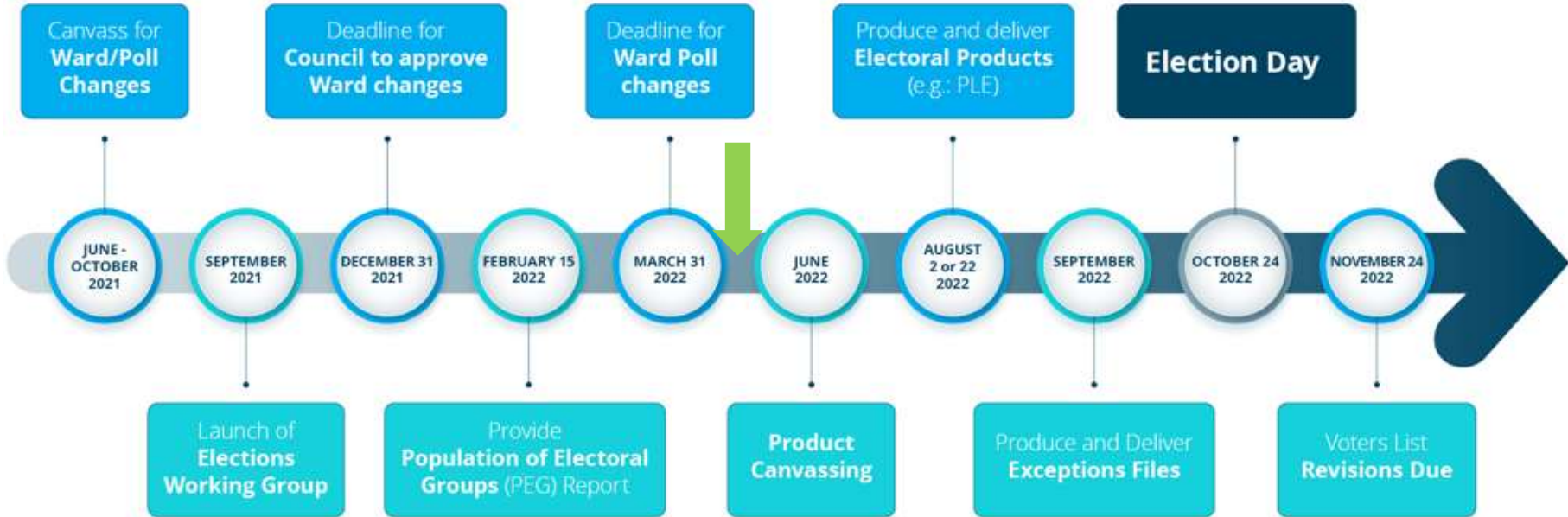

MPAC's online web service that allows electors to confirm and update their information for municipal elections

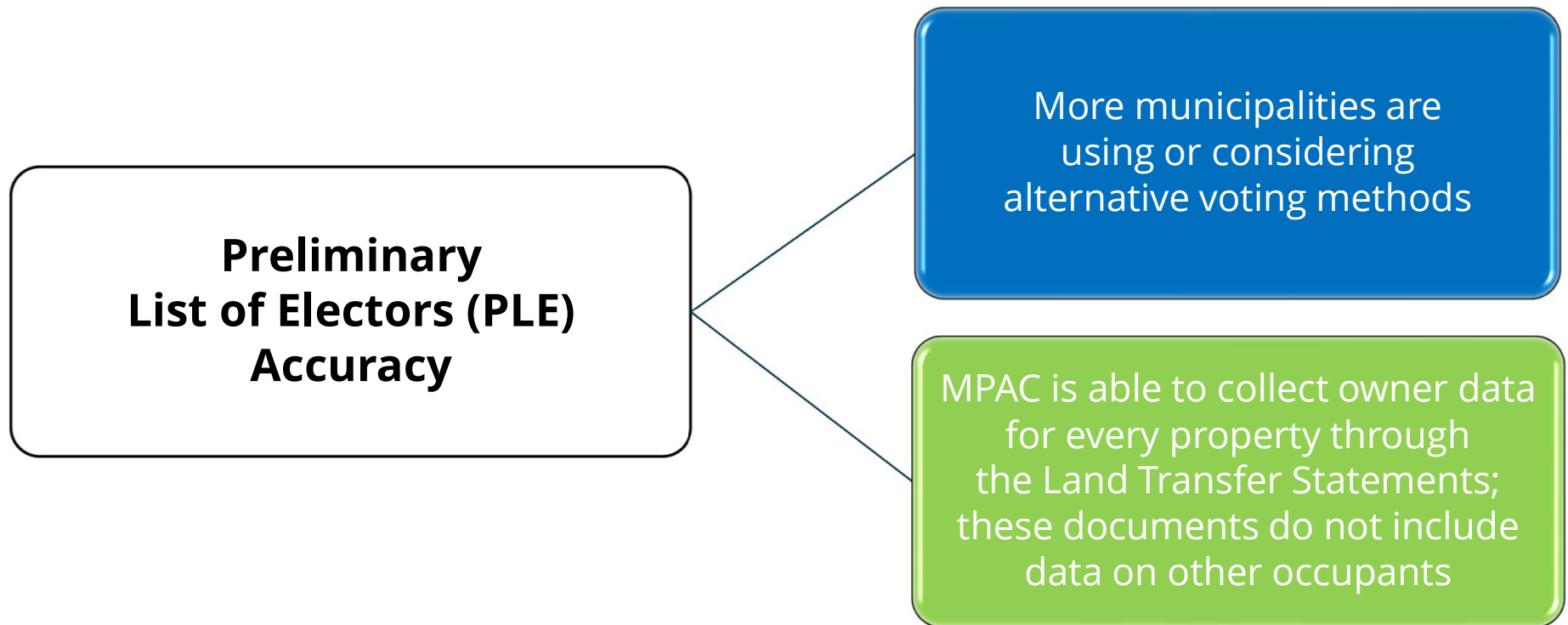
Available year-round, 24 hours a day

Allows eligible electors to:

- confirm or update their information
- add a name to an address
- change their school support for electoral purposes

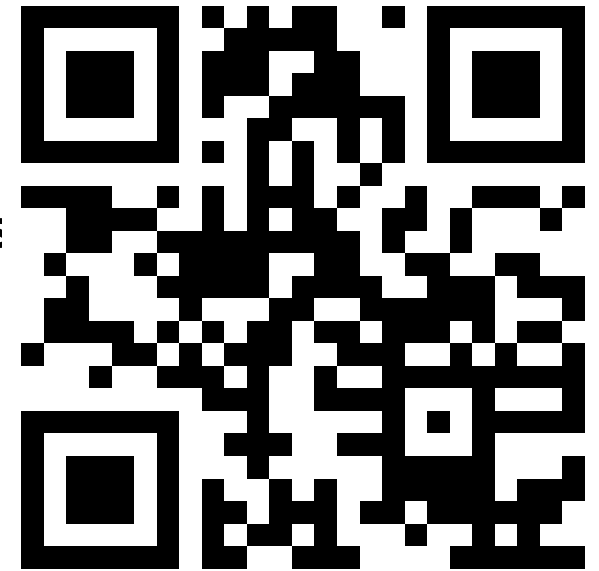

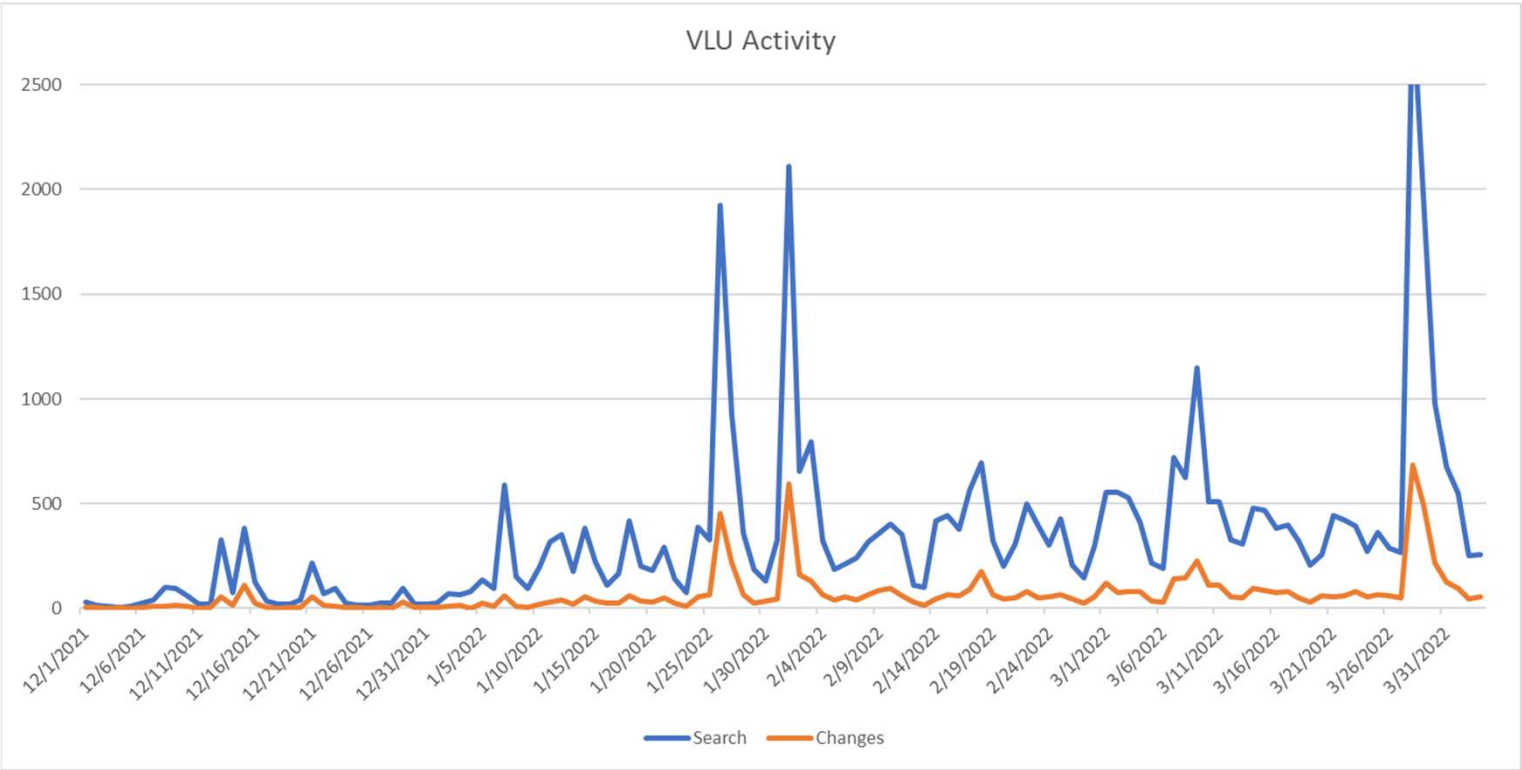

School Support Modernization Project

Project Overview

- Fall 2020 - Government of Ontario passed legislation to allow MPAC to improve its school support data collection process, including allowing electronic submission of school support, starting in 2023.
- Fall 2021 - MPAC launched a project team to modernize our operational processes.
- As part of the modernization initiative, MPAC is:
 - Developing an online application to allow individuals to confirm/direct school support.
 - Engaging school boards (and school board associations) in the project to gather feedback on current school support data process.

School Support Modernization Project

Status

- MPAC has identified IT requirements to develop the online platform.
- February 2022 - MPAC held initial engagement with school boards and associations to:
 - provide an overview of the current school support system
 - discuss concerns and issues
 - Outline MPAC's initiative and receive initial feedback.
- Meeting included representation from many school boards types and 3/4 school board associations
- Next Steps (Spring/Summer 2022)
 - Continue development of new MPAC online application
 - Continue engagement with school boards - demonstrate prototype of the online application, and improve based on feedback
