Subject: Zone 2 Annual Financial Report to the Board- 2025

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In accordance with the AMCTO Zone Terms of Reference, it is my pleasure to provide the Zone 2 annual report to the Board, outlining the various initiatives of Zone 2 for 2025.

### Summary of Zone Activities

Zone 2 held its Spring meeting virtually on Friday, April 11, 2025. The agenda included Zone and AMCTO updates, as well as learning sessions that supported member professional development (including Elections Ontario updates and wellness/mental health content). The Zone 2 Executive continues to attract new members, and it continues to feature on-going involvement from returning members. In 2025, the Zone elections resulted in a well-rounded, wholesome Zone 2 executive, including 16 engaged members looking to provide value to the Zone.

Zone 2 held its first ever joint in-person Fall Meeting with Zone 4 on Thursday, October 16, 2025, at the Zancor Centre, Township of King. This marked a significant milestone for both the Zones, making it the first ever joint meeting for both zones. The successful collaboration between Zones 2 and 4 brought members together for a full-day, in-person professional development and networking event. The joint format enabled broader participation, shared learning, and strengthened connections across Zones.

The result was an exceptional agenda with engaging and timely topics on: Cemetery Transformation, Accessible document conversion, municipal election preparedness, and Microsoft 365 and SharePoint technology. These sessions reflected a balance of operational, governance, and innovative topics relevant to clerks and municipal professionals.

The Fall meeting was also extremely successful with regards to sponsorship, featuring seven sponsorship partners. The agenda feature dedicated sponsor spotlight segments and recognition of event sponsors, whose support contributed to the success of the in-person event and helped offset meeting costs. This reinforced the Zone's ability to continue delivering high-quality, accessible programming.

The Joint Zone 2 and 4 Fall Meeting was a highly successful and well-attended event, delivering meaningful professional development, reinforcing inter-zone collaboration, and providing valuable networking opportunities. The breadth of topics, strong leadership participation, and sponsor support collectively contributed to a positive and engaging member experience.

As we look ahead to 2026, the Spring meeting will be brought back in person, to allow for meaningful in-person dialogue and networking.

**Financial Highlights**

“As of October 31, 2024, Zone 2 had an opening balance of \$6,247.36 with an ending balance of \$6,746.11 as of October 31, 2025. Zone 2 continues to remain in a healthy financial position to support their members.

A comprehensive Treasurer’s Report is available as Attachment # to this report. As Zone 2 proceeds to hold both Spring and Fall meetings in-person, it is anticipated that there may be additional costs, such as; changing banking institutions to allow for online payments, additional expenses in providing meeting content. Zone 2 expects to manage these potential costs while maintaining a positive financial position. Any additional surplus will be allocated to support upcoming learning and development opportunities.”

**Looking Forward**

Zone 2 continues to be supported by positive engagement from its members. While we have seen some turnover in this term on the Executive, due to changes in roles and retirements, we continue to provide value to all members and look to enhance their experiences within the Zone.
